Difference Scores:
Denoted by **D/S, the difference between two rows.
Ex. Row A - Row B

Ratios: Denoted by **Ratio, the ratio between two rows.
Ex. Row A ÷ Row B

Both difference scores and ratios can provide quick and powerful findings to analysts and other users.

Special Points:
Often called combo points, these points show the cases where two or more variables converge.

Ex. 16% of cases represent a calculated variable of those with a favorable opinion of one candidate but not his opponent.
